Elevier Women's Center

Elevier Women's Center in Elk River offers free, confidential support for women and families navigating unexpected pregnancies. The center provides free pregnancy testing, on-site ultrasounds with medical staff, and STI testing and treatment. ~Support goes beyond medical care. Elevier offers 1:1 education, pregnancy and parenting classes until a child turns two, and co-parenting support for young dads. Trained patient and client advocates walk alongside individuals and families as they navigate pregnancy, parenting, and next steps.

Elevier does not provide or refer for birth control, pregnancy termination, fertility treatments, Pap tests, mammograms, or cancer screenings. This center exists to provide care, information & support—at no cost to those who need it
